Conference Resolutions

- That the LGSA hold another Local Government Tourism Conference in 2009 and that Tourism NSW continue to support and partner the conference.
- That the Minister for Tourism considers the development of a flexible template which will allow 1,4 and 10 year strategic tourism plans for Local Government to mirror the NSW Government's 10 year State Plan.
- That the LGSA request Tourism NSW to develop best practice models for Local Government investment in tourism.
- That LGSA request that the NSW Government review it's funding for infrastructure and services for regions and localities that have tourism responsibilities and impacts.
- That the Conference and the LGSA call for the reintroduction of regional rail services to:
 - support and promote tourism;
 - provide for commuters; and
 - mitigate greenhouse gas emissions.
- That the Premier expedite the release of the O'Neill Report into Tourism in NSW to allow councils to plan and budget for tourism in light of its recommendations.
